"I now have a weekly visit to 2 jails 40 miles apart to minister to 2 inmates. A brother age 60 who struggles with mental illness and crosses the law on occasion and my barbers son age 47 who has Introduced Bible Basics to read and study between visits in his cell. Thank you for providing this booklet of basic Bible teachings. My new friend is excited having never read the Bible to learn these truths and get baptized someday. I'm in transit shortly from the prison here to get my haircut in his mom's kitchen who I will also share a copy of this booklet with. Thank you for all your updates across the pond and the work you are doing in our Lords vineyard there. You are my inspiration to carry on here as we await that great day of our Lords appearing! Had to take 16 hours of security clearance classes to gain 24/7 access into the jail visiting rooms with a glass partition between us, as well as passing a background check. Here are a few pics!"

It was only about 10 days ago that Mark and Duncan visited brother Igor and his wife, one legged sister Nina, and gave them a goat. They live in a remote village. Igor had already been taken to the army but had a bad heart attack whilst undergoing military training and was released. But the day after we gave them the goat, the military Police came through the village again and grabbed brother Igor. He has been mobilized without further training and sent to a front line town. His phone has been taken from him, but he gave Nina's number to another soldier, who contacted her and told her Igor is alive but at the front. Nina is in great stress and despair. We do ask your urgent prayers that Igor will be somehow preserved and that Nina will be able to survive in the village alone without him, despite her disability. At first blush, some of you may consider some of it rather "worldly". But remember our aim. We are out to engage standard, secular working class people in South London. And lead them further. And we are at the cutting edge of engagement with standard, secular society- and we consider it's great that we can engage with so many of them through such events. Folks who attend our meetings now and again brought their friends and relatives to the garden party; and the next day, our Sunday service was packed, including quite a few new attenders who had come to the garden party the day before. Whether one likes the style or not, the Lord is working through all this work and outreaching to so many secular people of either no faith or very nominal "Christian" faith. And they are very open to our desire to teach them from the Bible. These folks have open minds and few pre-existing doctrinal ideas.

Who would've thought that in secular, working class South London, the Lord would find so much good ground for His seed.
